- 1:30-2:00** - *The Barber of Seville* by Rossini: exciting activities to study the opera's story and music.
- 2:00-4:00** - Theater workshops, visits from special guests, scenes rehearsal and snack.

Activities and Guests

Activities will center on the time period and action in the opera *The Barber of Seville*. Campers will study the opera in-depth and learn a large portion of the music. Lyric Opera stage director, Linda Ade Brand will provide daily theater workshops to lead campers in exploring the basics of creating realistic characterizations and story theater techniques.
